

Sterling State Park Surveying

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Michigan Department of Natural Resources (MDNR) used 8.7 million dollars of Clean Michigan Initiative (CMI) grant funds to renovate the Sterling State Park located on the shore of Lake Erie in Monroe County, Michigan.

The Mannik & Smith Group, Inc. (MSG) was contracted to provide construction surveying services through the general contractor, SG Construction Services. This consisted of staking out potential building layouts, campsites, roadways, parking lots, pedestrian pathways, water lines, sanitary sewer lines, and storm water drainage systems.

MSG also provided the survey coordination for wetland preservation and sedimentation control measures.
